Description	Screen for the most commonly abused stimulant laxatives: bisacodyl, danthron, phenolphthalein and rhein.
Indication	Suspected laxative abuse.
Additional Info	Diarrhoea, constipation, abdominal pain, dehydration, electrolyte disturbances (hypokalaemia, hypomagnesaemia) and excessive weight loss may be indicators of laxative abuse.
Concurrent Tests	None
Dietary Requirements	None
Interpretation	To confidently determine or eliminate laxative abuse, samples taken on 2 or 3 consecutive days should be sent.
Collection Conditions	Urine (random)
Frequency of testing	As required.
