

## Mycophenolate (Mofetil)

<b>Description</b>	Mycophenolate mofetil is an immunosuppressant drug that is used for prophylaxis of acute renal, cardiac, or hepatic transplant rejection (in combination with ciclosporin and corticosteroids) under specialist supervision It is metabolised to mycophenolic acid which has a more selective mode of action than azathioprine
<b>Indication</b>	Therapeutic drug monitoring
